The National Commission for the Promotion of Equality (NCPE) works towards ensuring that the Maltese society is free from discrimination.



What grounds does the National Commission for the Promotion of Equality cover?

- Sex/gender and family responsibilities
 - Sexual orientation
 - Age
 - Religion or belief
 - Racial or ethnic origin
 - Gender identity, gender expression or sex characteristics
- in employment, banks and financial institutions, and education**

- Racial/ethnic origin
 - Gender
- in the access to goods and services**

- Freedom of movement for workers in the EU

What can I do if I am discriminated?

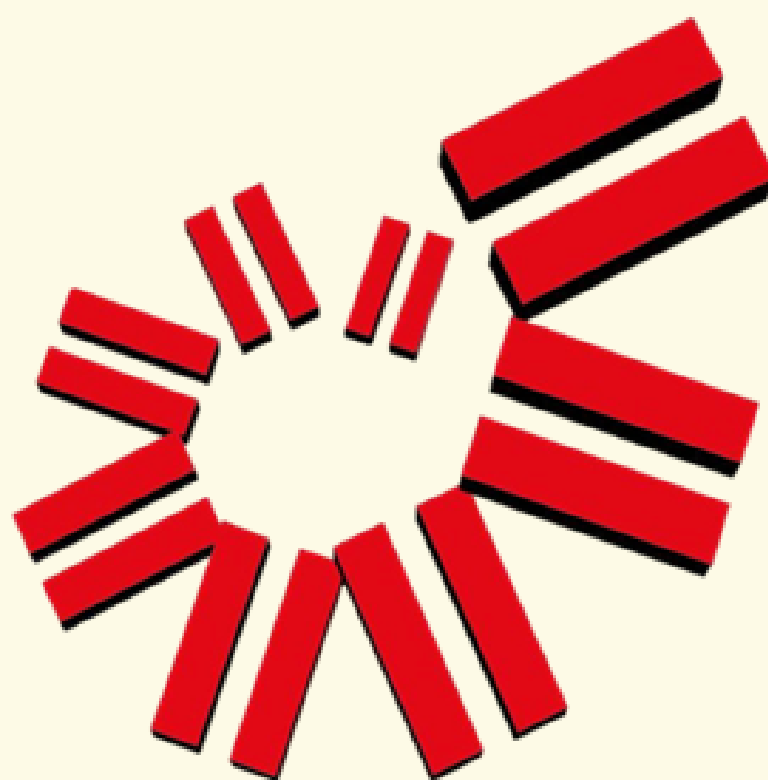
