





'Have your say!' on equality and discrimination

'Have Your Say" is a campaign to raise awareness and sensitivity on equality and non-discrimination in respect to the six grounds of discrimination under NCPE's remit, namely gender, religion / belief, race / ethnicity, age, sexual orientation and gender identity. This campaign is being organised by the National Commission for the Promotion of Equality (NCPE) throughout the month of March. 'Have your say!' initiative is giving the opportunity to individuals to share their views on the effects of discrimination and equality, as well as raise their concerns on discriminatory cases which they have experienced or witnessed.

The 'Have Your Say!' roving booth has been visiting various localities around Malta and Gozo to empower individuals and provide citizens with a safe space where they can walk in freely and 'have their say'. The clips gathered throughout the campaign will be studied to assess the needs and wants as recounted in the video. Moreover, these clips will be edited and then disseminated at the national conference and subsequently in the local media to create awareness on the findings.

This campaign is being organised as part of the EU co-funded project 'Enhancing Equal Rights', PROGRESS (2007-2013). The main objectives of this project is to facilitate and accelerate the implementation phase of NCPE's newly extended remit by strengthening the internal knowledge capacity; creating awareness on equality and non-discrimination and empowering stakeholders through training.
