in the access to goods and services

freedom of movement for workers in the EU

What can I do if I am discriminated?

Where can I learn more about equality and discrimination?

- The NCPE gives training upon request on a range of subjects connected to equality, diversity, and non-discrimination.
- The NCPE answers specific <u>requests for</u> <u>information</u> related to equality.
- The NCPE publishes <u>research findings</u> on topics that are relevant.

What is the NCPE Equality Mark?

- The NCPE Equality Mark is a certification awarded to companies/organisations that make gender equality one of their values and whose management is based on the recognition and promotion of the potential of all employees irrespective of their gender and caring responsibilities.
- The Equality Mark certification can be renewed after a period of 2 years.
- Eligibility: Private and public entities.



What is the Directory for Professional Women?

- The **Directory for Professional Women** gives visibility and more opportunities to professional and competent women for appointment on boards and committees, and/or to assume decision-making positions in the labour market.
- Eligibility women with 5 years experience in a decision-making/management position; and/or 10 years specialised expertise in a particular field.
